More than 10 Greater Shepparton mothers have received much-needed prams for their babies thanks to the Sir Andrew

and Lady Fairley Foundation.
Goulburn Valley Pregnancy
and Family Support Services
lead practitioner Maree Chin said in September the service reached a crisis situation when its supply of prams was depleted.

At the time, 12 needy mothers were on a waiting list for a pram," she said.

After approaching the founda-

tion, the Caroline Chisholm Society's rural branch received a \$2100 grant to buy new prams as well as offering to buy appro-priate second-hand prams through a community drive in the future.

The service is also looking for more volunteers and Ms Chin encouraged anyone who thought they would be suited to phone the office on 5821 0826.




